Safe and responsible travel, always.

As you look to get back on the road, we continue to ensure our trips are safe for everyone. That includes our travellers, our leaders and crew and the people we visit along the way. Our health and safety policies follow recommendations from the World Health Organization and the World Travel & Tourism Council's (WTTC) Safe Travel protocols for tour operators. Before we resume trips in any destination, our itineraries undergo a comprehensive risk assessment and audit, while leaders and suppliers will complete COVID-19 health and safety training. We have also introduced specific policies around testing and vaccination for your safety.

On the 29th July 2021 we introduced new safety measures that apply on all of our trips, except for tours in Australia and New Zealand. Travellers are required to produce:

- Proof of COVID-19 vaccination

In all cases, you must be fully inoculated. This means you must receive the full dosage of the COVID-19 vaccine and allow enough time for immunity to take effect. Each COVID-19 vaccine has different dosages and timeframes for inoculation, so please check the relevant medical advice associated with your vaccine.

These new safety measures that apply on all of our trips, except for tours in Australia, New Zealand and the Cook Islands. From the 1st December 2021 travellers are required to produce proof of COVID-19 vaccination on all of our trips.

If you are unable to be vaccinated for medical reasons, you may apply for an exemption. Exemptions will be assessed on a case-by-case basis. To apply, you must provide a medical certificate from a medical professional.

Children under 18 are exempt. Children aged between 5 and 17 years old must provide proof of either vaccination, recovery or a negative COVID-19 test. Please see the below section on children for further details.

About your Tour Leader


Group leader

We transfer to Amzmiz on 2 hour journey. Our ride starts here going through the first hills of the High Atlas Mountains before a challenging climb of 7 KM before descending down to the region of Ouirgane where we have our lunch and spend rest of the day.

Drive until the intersection point to Telout (2 hours transfer as we can't bike before that being busy road for large group) and start our ride. 60 KM of mostly downhill through the valleys and the town of Telouat where we can stop for lunch.

Today, we'll leave the Todra and head into Jbel Saghro, a desert mountain range situated after the Atlas mountains and the gateway to the Sahara Desert. It doesn't take us long to hit our first climb of Touririte Peak, which hits the summit at approximately 2,000m, where there is the small town of Iknouen. Here, we start to isolate ourselves as we enter into the mountain plateau with vast beautiful valleys, dry river beds and more remote Berber Villages, where you can see the village children playing all the way to Alnif, which is our ride destination. We take a short transfer to Erfoud (Arfoud), which is our home for the night, where you can explore this mainly tourist destination.

Commence the long, winding ride up into the Atlas Mountains and the small town of Anmiter. It is here that the cycling part of our adventure ends as we climb into our support vehicle and drive, avoiding a serious amount of climbing, to the spectacular Tizi n'Tichka Pass. At 2260 metres above sea level, this is the highest major mountain pass in North Africa. After a brief break for refreshment and a photo stop, re-join the support vehicle and descend from the High Atlas Mountains back to Marrakech, some 100 kilometres away. Once back in Marrakech, transfer to airport.

Once the tour has been confirmed final payment will be due no later than 70 days prior to travel. We can only hold arrangements for a group once we have received deposit.
